Course Overview

This one-day leadership development course equips executives and emerging leaders with a focused set of twelve critical leadership functions—the core, intentional behaviors that high-impact leaders must consistently demonstrate. Rather than prescribing a one-size-fits-all leadership model, this course emphasizes a "form follows function" approach: participants will first explore and assess these universal leadership functions, then examine the forms these functions might take based on their personal style, organizational culture, and strategic context. Through guided reflection, peer feedback, and real-time application, leaders will identify how to make their actions more visible, intentional, and aligned with what their organizations need most from them. The course is designed to be practical, personalized, and immediately applicable to the realities of executive leadership.

- 1. Apply structured approaches to decision-making, communication, and organizational planning.
- 2. Strengthen team performance through empowerment, delegation, and coaching.
- 3. Enhance executive functioning skills including emotional control, planning, and flexible thinking.
- 4. Cultivate a purpose-driven leadership mindset that integrates vision, integrity, and innovation.
